A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE 4-H CAMPS AND CONFERENCE CENTERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of thirty-four million four hundred sixty-nine thousand dollars (\$34,469,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of thirty-four million four hundred sixty-nine thousand dollars (\$34,469,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be allocated to the agricultural programs fund of the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at North Carolina State University for repairs, renovations, and new construction in the North Carolina 4-H Camping System properties as follows:

- (1) \$750,000 to the Anita Alta 4-H Outpost Camp (Caldwell County).
- 14 (2) \$3,849,000 to the Betsy Jeff Penn 4-H Camp (Rockingham County).
  - (3) \$8,500,000 to the 4-H Center (Tyrrell County).
- 16 (4) \$4,985,000 to the Millstone 4-H Camp (Richmond County).
- 17 (5) \$5,635,000 to the Sertoma 4-H Camp (Stokes County).
- 18 (6) \$10,550,000 to the Swannanoa 4-H Camps (Camden County).
- 19 \$250,000 to Camden County 4-H Camps (Camden County).
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
