3 COMMITTEE ON THE EDUCATION OF STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES TO
4 ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-106.3 is amended by adding the following new
7 subdivisions to read:

8 "(3a) 'Educational services' means all of the following:

- 9 a. The necessary instructional hours per week in the form and
10 format as determined by the child's IEP team and consistent
11 with federal and State law in order to provide the child with a
12 free appropriate public education and a sound basic education.
13 The instruction shall be delivered from a teacher certified to
14 teach children with disabilities or a teacher who is certified in
15 the subject of instruction to the extent allowed by IDEA and the
16 federal No Child Left Behind Act.
17 b. Related services included in the child's IEP.
18 c. Behavior intervention services designed to address the behavior
19 violation that caused the disciplinary change of placement in
20 order to prevent a reoccurrence.

21 (5a) 'Homebound instruction' means educational services provided to a
22 student outside the school setting."

23 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
