A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ENSURE THAT SCHOOL FOOD
SERVICE PROGRAMS HAVE ADEQUATE RESOURCES TO OFFER AND
PROMOTE HEALTHY, NUTRITIOUS FOOD CHOICES TO STUDENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Public Instruction the sum of fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) for the
2007-2008 fiscal year to ensure that school food service programs have adequate
resources to offer and promote healthy, nutritious food choices to students. The State
Board of Education shall use these funds to hold local school administrative units
harmless for any decrease in revenues due to the implementation of new laws and
policies regarding child nutrition.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
