The district attorney in prosecutorial districts 1, 3B, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15A, 15B, 16A, 18, 19B, 20A, 20B, 21, 22, 24, 25, 26, 27A, 27B, 28, 29A, 29B, and 30 is entitled to one investigatorial assistant, and the district attorney in prosecutorial district <u>districts</u> 10 and 20A is entitled to two investigatorial assistants, to be appointed by the district attorney and to serve at his pleasure.

6 It shall be the duty of the investigatorial assistant to investigate cases preparatory to 7 trial and to perform such other Duties as may be assigned by the district attorney. The 8 investigatorial assistant is entitled to reimbursement for his subsistence and travel 9 expenses to the same extent as State employees generally."

10 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial 11 Department the sum of three hundred sixty-six thousand eighty-four dollars (\$366,084) 12 for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred forty-nine thousand nine 13 hundred seventy dollars (\$349,970) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to fund the two 14 additional assistant district attorneys authorized for Prosecutorial District 20A by this 15 act, the additional investigatorial assistant authorized for District 20A by this act, and 16 two victim witness legal assistants for District 20A.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
