Whereas, Interact has already received substantial support from Wake County, and is actively seeking support from the City of Raleigh and all municipalities within Wake County, as well as from federal sources, toward the \$5,000,000 needed for the acquisition, renovation, and equipping of the new facility; and

Whereas, support for this effort is coming from individuals, foundations, and corporations as well as public sources for this effort, called The Campaign for a Safe Place; Now, therefore,

27 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Family
28 Violence Prevention Center, Inc. (Interact), a nonprofit organization, the sum of five

- 1 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to retrofit and
- 2 renovate the former Oberlin Road YWCA building in Wake County to expand its
- 3 services to victims and survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault.
- 4 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
