The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 143B-434.1(c) reads as rewritten: The Board shall consist of 27 29 members as follows: "(c) The Secretary of Commerce, who shall not be a voting member. (1)(2)The Director of the Division of Tourism, Film, and Sports Development, who shall not be a voting member. Two members designated by the Board of Directors of the North (3)Carolina Hotel and Motel Association. Two members designated by the Board of Directors of the North (4) Carolina Restaurant Association. Three Directors of Convention and Visitor Bureaus designated by the (5) Board of Directors of the North Carolina Association of Convention and Visitor Bureaus. (6)The Chairperson of the Travel and Tourism Coalition. The President of the Travel Council of North Carolina. (7)A member designated by the Board of Directors of the Travel Council (8) of North Carolina. (9) The President of North Carolina Citizens for Business and Industry. (10)One member designated by the North Carolina Petroleum Marketers Association. (11)One person associated with tourism attractions in North Carolina,
