One person 3 who is not a member of the General Assembly, appointed by the 4 President Pro Tempore of the Senate. 5 Four public members each interested in matters relating to travel and (13)6 tourism, two appointed by the Governor (one from a rural area and one 7 from an urban area), one appointed by the Speaker of the House, and 8 one appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. 9 (14)One member associated with the major cultural resources and activities 10 of the State in North Carolina, appointed by the Governor. 11 Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the (15)12 Speaker of the House of Representatives. 13 (16)Two members of the Senate, appointed by the President Pro Tempore 14 of the Senate. 15 Two members designated by the Board of Directors of North Carolina (17)Watermen United who represent the charter boat/headboat industry." 16 17 **SECTION 2.** The members of the Board added under Section 1 of this act 18 shall serve a first term beginning on the date of their designation and ending on 19 December 31, 2009. Thereafter, they shall serve two-year terms which shall begin on 20 January 1 of an even-numbered year and end on December 31 of the following year. 21 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
