3	SHALL STUDY THE NORTH CAROLINA PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND			
4	STORAGE TANK PROGRAM AS WELL AS THE RETURN TO USE OF SITES			
5	IMPACTED BY LEAKING TANKS.			
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
7	SECTION 1. The Environmental Review Commission shall study the North			
8	Carolina petroleum underground storage tank program and the problems of returning to			
9	use sites impacted by leaking underground storage tanks. The following issues shall be			
10	examined in the	study:		
11	(1)	The role of "risk based corrective action" in protecting both public		
12		health and the environment.		
13	(2)	An assessment of whether DENR has fully utilized risk based		
14		corrective action in the program to date and whether implements could		
15		be made to fully utilize existing financial resources in the future.		
16	(3)	An assessment of the pace of clean up "closures", and the DENR's		
17		experience with issuing letters of "no further action required"		
18		including whether contamination is being addressed promptly and		
19		impacted parcels being made eligible for desired commercial		
20		transactions that follow appropriate remediation.		
21	(4)	An assessment of fair and equitable funding needs facing the State and		
22		the tank owning segment with an examination of solvency issues		
23		experienced in the present or expected in the future.		
24	(5)	An examination and survey of other states to determine "model		
25		solutions" to address the challenges of financing environmental		
26		cleanups following a tank release and the expedited return of impacted		
27		parcels to needed and normal real estate commerce.		

- SECTION 2. The Commission shall make an interim report on its findings
 no later than May 1, 2008, and a final report to the 2009 Regular Session of the General
- 3 Assembly no later than January 15, 2009.
- 4 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
