AN ACT TO REVISE THE LAW GOVERNING ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES BY  
CLARIFYING THAT PUBLIC AGENCIES MAY USE, AS WELL AS ACCEPT,  
ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 66-58.4 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 66-58.4. Use of electronic signatures.**

All public agencies may use and accept electronic signatures pursuant to this Article, pursuant to Article 40 of this Chapter (the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act), or pursuant to other law."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June, 2007.
