SESSION LAW 2007-2 SENATE BILL 50

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE THE POTENTIAL FOR AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER STATES FOR THE RECIPROCAL HONORING OF HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES FOR THE DISABLED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall, pursuant to its authority under G.S. 113-275(a), investigate the potential for agreements with other jurisdictions for the reciprocal honoring of hunting and fishing licenses for the disabled. **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
