A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DURHAM TO EXPEDITE REMOVAL OF
REFUSE AND DEBRIS BY AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF CHRONIC
VIOLATOR.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2003-133 reads as rewritten:

7 "SECTION 1. A municipality may notify a chronic violator of the municipality's 8 refuse and debris ordinance that, if the violator's property is found to be in violation of the ordinance, the municipality may, without further notice in the calendar year in 9 10 which the notice is given, take action to remedy the violation, and the expense of the action shall become a lien upon the violator's property and shall be collected as unpaid 11 taxes. The initial annual notice shall be served by registered or certified mail. Under 12 this section, a chronic violator is a person who owns property whereupon, in the 13 14 previous calendar year, the municipality took remedial action at least three-two times 15 under the refuse and debris ordinance."

- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act applies to the City of Durham only.
- 17 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
