A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REMOVE DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MCADENVILLE AND ANNEX IT TO THE TOWN OF CRAMERTON, IF APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARDS OF THOSE TWO TOWNS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The following described property is removed from the corporate limits of the Town of McAdenville and is added to the corporate limits of the Town of Cramerton:

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall have no effect upon the validity of any liens of the Town of McAdenville for ad valorem taxes or special assessments outstanding before the effective date of this act. Such liens may be collected or foreclosed upon after the effective date of this act as though the property was still within the corporate limits of the Town of McAdenville.

SECTION 3. This act is effective only if the governing boards of the Towns of Cramerton and McAdenville by ordinance approve of the boundary changes in Section 1 of this act.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective June 30, 2007.
