The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 163-123(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Defeated Primary Candidate. – No person whose name appeared on the ballot in a primary election preliminary to the general election shall be eligible to have votes counted for him as a write-in candidate for the same any office in that year."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective with respect to elections held on or after September 1, 2009.
