2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR TWO ADDITIONAL MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY
3 COUNCIL ON INDIAN EDUCATION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-210.1 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 115C-210.1. Membership – How appointed.**

7 The Council shall consist of ~~15~~ 17 members, as follows:

- 8 (1) Two legislative members (one senator appointed by the President Pro
9 Tempore of the Senate and one representative appointed by the Speaker of
10 the House);
- 11 (2) Two Indian members from higher education to be appointed by the Board of
12 Governors of the University system;
- 13 (3) One Indian member from the North Carolina Commission on Indian Affairs
14 to be appointed by that Commission;
- 15 (4) ~~Eight~~ Nine Indian parents of students enrolled in public schools and ~~two~~
16 three Indian educators from public elementary/secondary schools to be
17 appointed by the State Board of Education from a list submitted by the North
18 Carolina Commission on Indian Affairs;
- 19 (5) Indian members of the Council shall be broadly representative of North
20 Carolina Indian tribes and organizations, specifically, the Eastern Band of
21 Cherokee, Lumbee, Coharie, Waccamaw-Siouan, Haliwa Saponi, Meherrin,
22 Person County Indians, Cumberland County Association for Indian People,
23 the Guilford Native American Association, the Metrolina Native American
24 Association, and any other Indian tribe gaining State recognition in the
25 future."

26 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
