2 AN ACT TO EXPAND THE ENERGY STAR QUALIFIED PRODUCTS THAT QUALIFY  
3 FOR THE SALES AND USE TAX HOLIDAY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 105-164.13D(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 105-164.13D. Sales and use tax holiday for Energy Star qualified products.**

7 (a) The taxes imposed by this Article do not apply to the Energy Star qualified products  
8 with a sales price of six thousand dollars (\$6,000) or less per item listed in this section if sold  
9 between 12:01 A.M. on the first Friday of November and 11:59 P.M. the following Sunday.  
10 The qualified products ~~are~~ are the following:

- 12 (8) Battery chargers.
  - 13 (9) Dishwashers.
  - 14 (10) Room air cleaners.
  - 15 (11) Residential water heaters.
  - 16 (12) Boilers.
  - 17 (13) Furnaces.
  - 18 (14) Ventilating fans.
  - 19 (15) Insulation.
  - 20 (16) Air sealing products.
  - 21 (17) Windows.
  - 22 (18) Doors.
  - 23 (19) Skylights.
  - 24 (20) Cordless phones.
  - 25 (21) External power adapters.
  - 26 (22) Compact fluorescent light bulbs.
  - 27 (23) Decorative light strings.
  - 28 (24) Residential light fixtures."

29 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and applies to sales made on  
30 or after that date.
