40 47	SECTION 7.(a) Water Transfer Certificates. – Interbasin transfer certificates issued by the Environmental Management Commission under G.S. 143-215.22I, 143-215.22L,				
48	or 153A-285 prior to July 1, 2009, shall continue in effect. A person who has a certificate				
49	issued prior to July 1, 2009, may request a modification of the certification consistent with this				
50	act. A modification request shall be subject to the notice and hearing requirements set out in				
51	subdivision (3) of subsection (c) of G.S. 143-215.22L.				

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Water Classifications Unchanged. - This act shall not be SECTION 7.(b) 1 2 interpreted to change the water quality classification of a water. Any classification that was 3 applied to all waters within a river basin as it was defined prior to July 1, 2009, shall apply only 4 to waters located within the river basin before that date. Reclassification of waters shall require 5 rule making. 6

SECTION 8. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
