A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF
NORTH CAROLINA TO RECOGNIZE THE CHEROKEE LANGUAGE AS A
LANGUAGE FOR WHICH A STUDENT MAY SATISFY A FOREIGN LANGUAGE
COURSE REQUIREMENT FOR DEGREE COMPLETION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 116-11 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(4c) The Board of Governors shall require each constituent institution to develop and implement a policy that recognizes the Cherokee language as a language for which a student may satisfy the foreign language course requirement for degree completion at the institution."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the
2011-2012 academic year and each subsequent year.
