Short Title: Modify Habitual Impaired Driving Statute. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE HABITUAL IMPAIRED DRIVING STATUTE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-138.5(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) A person commits the offense of habitual impaired driving if ~~he~~the person drives while impaired as defined in G.S. 20-138.1 and has been convicted of three or more offenses involving impaired driving as defined in ~~G.S. 20-4.01(24a)~~ within 10 years of the date of this offense.G.S. 20-4.01(24a)."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
