## Referred to: February 4, 2013 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A CHARTER SCHOOL IS A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT 3 FOR THE PURPOSE OF A LEASE OR TRANSFER OF PERSONAL OR REAL 4 PROPERTY BETWEEN A CHARTER SCHOOL AND ANOTHER GOVERNMENTAL 5 UNIT. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-274(a) reads as rewritten: 8 For the purposes of this section, "governmental unit" means a city, county, school "(a) 9 administrative unit, charter school, sanitary district, fire district, the State, or any other public 10 district, authority, department, agency, board, commission, or institution." SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-238.29H(a1) reads as rewritten: 11 12 "(a1) Funds allocated by the State Board of Education may be used to enter into operational and financing leases for real property or mobile classroom units for use as school 13 14 facilities for charter schools and may be used for payments on loans made to charter schools for facilities or equipment. However, State funds shall not be used to obtain any other interest in 15 real property or mobile classroom units. No indebtedness of any kind incurred or created by the 16 17 charter school shall constitute an indebtedness of the State or its political subdivisions, and no indebtedness of the charter school shall involve or be secured by the faith, credit, or taxing 18 19 power of the State or its political subdivisions. Every contract or lease into which a charter 20 school enters shall include the previous sentence. The school also may own land and buildings it obtains through non-State sources.sources and as provided in G.S. 160A-274." 21 SECTION 3. G.S. 160A-280(b) reads as rewritten: 22 23 For the purposes of this section, the term "governmental unit" shall have the same "(b) 24 meaning as defined by G.S. 160A-274(a) and shall include North Carolina charter schools.has 25 the same meaning as set forth in G.S. 160A-274(a)." 26 SECTION 4. G.S. 115C-238.29F(i) reads as rewritten: Assets. - Upon Except as provided under subsection (i1) of this section, upon 27 "(i) dissolution of the charter school or upon the nonrenewal of the charter, all net assets of the 28 29 charter school purchased with public funds shall be deemed the property of the local school 30 administrative unit in which the charter school is located." **SECTION 5.** G.S. 115C-238.29F is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 31 32 Real Property. - Before disposing of any real property received pursuant to "(i1) G.S. 160A-274 for less than full and fair market value, a charter school shall afford the 33 governmental unit from which the real property was received the first opportunity to obtain the 34 35 real property for the same or less consideration given by the recipient charter school."

**SECTION 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
