A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DURHAM TO ALLOW PAYMENT FOR ON-STREET PARKING BY VARIOUS MEANS AND TO USE PROCEEDS FROM ON-STREET PARKING FOR PARKING PROGRAMS AND PROVIDING PARKING FACILITIES.		
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-301 reads as rewritten:		
"§ 160A-301. Parking.		
(a) O	n-Street Parking A city may by ordinance regulate, restrict, and prohibit the	

9 parking of vehicles on the public streets, alleys, and bridges within the city. When parking is 10 permitted for a specified period of time at a particular location, a city may install a parking 11 meter at that location and require any person parking a vehicle therein to place the meter in 12 operation pay a fee for the entire time that the vehicle remains in that location, up to the 13 14 maximum time allowed for parking there. Parking meters may be activated by coins or tokens. The city may require that payment for vehicle parking be made by a means of payment 15 specified by the city, including coins, currency, tokens, credit cards, or electronic means. 16 Proceeds from the use of parking meters or devices for parking on public streets must be used 17 18 to defray the cost of enforcing and administering traffic and parking ordinances and regulations.operating the city's parking program or providing parking facilities. 19 " 20

SECTION 2. This act applies to the City of Durham only.
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
