The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
S	ECTION 1. The Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671 of	of the 1975
Session Laws, as amended, is amended by adding a new section to read as follows:		
"Sec. 2.8. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 160A-31(i) and G.S. 160A-58.7(b), in an		
annexation ordinance adopted under Part 1 or Part 4 of Article 4A of Chapter 160A of the		
General Statutes, the city council may include in the description of the area to be annexed any		
adjacent streets or street rights-of-way."		

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
