6	SECTION 1. G.S. 15A-1340.16(e) is amended by adding a new subdivision to

8	"(14a) The defendant has been diagnosed as suffering from posttraumatic stress			
9	disorder resulting from his or her military service and is undergoing			
10	profes	professional treatment for that condition. As used in this section,		
11	<u>"postt</u>	"posttraumatic stress disorder" means the same as such term is defined in the		
12	Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, DSM-5, or			
13	subsequent editions published by the American Psychiatric Association, and			
14	occurred as a result of events during the service of the defendant in one or			
15	more combat zones. The defendant shall provide to the court documentary			
16	evidence that the defendant has done all of the following:			
17	<u>a.</u>	Served in the Armed Forces of the United State		
18		combat zone, as defined in section 112 of th		
19		Revenue Code of 1986. Proof of such service shall		
20		certification by the Secretary of Military and Ve	teran Affairs or a	
21		<u>Form DD-214.</u>		
22	<u>b.</u>	Been diagnosed with a posttraumatic stress disorder		
23		or her service in the Armed Forces of the United St		
24		. This act becomes effective October 1, 2017, and ap	plies to offenses	
25	committed on or after that date.
