1 A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MEMORY OF ROBERT W.
2 DALRYMPLE, FORMER MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

3 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple was born June 16, 1922, in Lee County to Clyde
4 and Eunice Dalrymple; and

5 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple graduated from North Carolina State College (North
6 Carolina State University); and

7 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple served in the United States Marines Corps, where
8 he fought in the Pacific Theater and received a Bronze Star and a Purple Heart; and

9 Whereas, after serving in the military, Robert W. Dalrymple returned to Lee
10 County, where he ran the family farm; and

11 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple served with honor and distinction in the General
12 Assembly as a member of the House of Representatives for two terms between 1949 and 1952;
13 and

14 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple served his community as a member and chair of the
15 Lee County Board of Education for over 20 years, a soil and water conservation district
16 supervisor, a trustee at Central Carolina Community College, and a charter member of the
17 Broadway Lion's Club; and

18 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple was a lifelong member of Salem Presbyterian
19 Church, where he served as Clerk of the Session for 50 years and was awarded Elder Emeritus;
20 and

21 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple was preceded in death by his wife of 63 years,
22 Nannie Lou McFarland Dalrymple; and

23 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple died on March 12, 2017, at the age of 94; and

24 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple is survived by two children and five grandchildren;

26 Whereas, Robert W. Dalrymple was a caring and remarkable man, who enriched the
27 lives of many and left an outstanding legacy of commitment to his family and community;
28 Now, therefore,

29 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

30 **SECTION 1.** The General Assembly honors the memory of Robert W. Dalrymple
31 and expresses its appreciation for the service that he rendered his community, State, and nation.

32 **SECTION 2.** The General Assembly extends its deepest sympathy to the family of
33 Robert W. Dalrymple for the loss of a beloved family member.

34 **SECTION 3.** The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this
35 resolution to the family of Robert W. Dalrymple.

36 **SECTION 4.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
