A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 TO INCREASE THE CHILD CARE SUBSIDY AN ACT MARKET RATES 3 RECOMMENDED BY THE 2015 CHILD CARE MARKET RATE STUDY FOR AGES 4 THREE THROUGH FIVE IN TIER THREE COUNTIES.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Beginning July 1, 2017, the Department of Health and Human 6 7 Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education, shall increase the child care subsidy market rates to the rates recommended by the 2015 Child Care Market Rate Study for 8 ages three through five years of age in three-, four-, and five-star-rated child care centers and 9 10 homes in tier three counties. For purposes of this act, a tier three county shall have the same designation as established by the N.C. Department of Commerce's 2015 County Tier 11 12 Designations.

13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education, the sum of 14 twelve million nine hundred thousand dollars (\$12,900,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 15 2017-2018 fiscal year to provide funds to increase the child care subsidy market rates 16 17 recommended by the 2015 Child Care Market Rate Study for ages three through five years of 18 age in three-, four-, and five-star-rated child care centers and homes in tier three counties. 19

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2017.
