A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF CORONER IN COLUMBUS AND CLEVELAND COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** The office of coroner in Columbus County is abolished.

**SECTION 1.(b)** Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable to Columbus County.

**SECTION 2.(a)** The office of coroner in Cleveland County is abolished.

**SECTION 2.(b)** Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable to Cleveland County.

**SECTION 2.(c)** This section is effective on the earlier of a vacancy in the office of coroner in Cleveland County or the expiration of the current elected term of office.

**SECTION 3.** Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes law.
