SECTION 1.(c) Implementation and Rule-Making Authority. – Before the effect				
date of the repeal of the Hospital Facilities Rules required pursuant to subsection (b) of the				
section, the Medical Care Commission shall adopt temporary rules to replace the Hospit				
	Facilities Rules and incorporate by reference all applicable rules, standards, and requirements			
	the most current edition of the Guidelines. If temporary rules are not adopted before the repeal of
