The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 14-404(e1) reads as rewritten:		
"(e1) The application for a permit shall be on a form created by the State Bureau of		
Investigation in consultation with the North Carolina Sheriffs' Association. This application shall		
be used by all sheriffs and must be provided by the sheriff both electronically and in paper form.		
Only the following shall be required to be submitted by an applicant for a permit:

No additional document or evidence shall be required from any applicant. Notwithstanding any		
other provision of law, a retired veteran applying for a permit may present a military identification		
card showing the veteran's retired status in lieu of a U.S. Department of Defense Form 214		
(DD-214). The military identification card shall satisfy any requirement under this article to		
present a military discharge document."		



SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2017.
