**SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-4.4(a) reads as rewritten:

7 The Commissioner may enter into an agreement or arrangement for interstate or "(a) intrastate-motor vehicle operations with the duly authorized representatives of another 8 jurisdiction, granting to vehicles or to owners of vehicles which are properly registered or 9 10 licensed in such jurisdiction and for which evidence of compliance is supplied, benefits, privileges and exemptions from the payment, wholly or partially, of any taxes, fees, or other 11 12 charges imposed upon such vehicles or owners with respect to the operation or ownership of such vehicles under the laws of this State. Such an agreement or arrangement shall provide that 13 14 vehicles properly registered or licensed in this State when operated upon highways of such other jurisdiction shall receive exemptions, benefits and privileges of a similar kind or to a 15 similar degree as are extended to vehicles properly registered or licensed in such jurisdiction 16 when operated in this State. Each such agreement or arrangement shall, in the judgment of the 17 18 Commissioner, be in the best interest of this State and the citizens thereof and shall be fair and equitable to this State and the citizens thereof, and all of the same shall be determined on the 19 basis and recognition of the benefits which accrue to the economy of this State from the 20 uninterrupted flow of commerce." 21
