3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 116-143.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
5	"(n) Notwithstanding other provisions of this section, an individual who (i) has attended
6	school in North Carolina for at least three consecutive years immediately prior to graduation
7	and (ii) has received a high school diploma from a school within North Carolina or has
8	obtained a general education diploma (GED) issued in North Carolina shall be accorded
9	resident tuition status."
10	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
