A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW A DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO FILE A PROBATION MODIFICATION PETITION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 15A-1344 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(b2) District Attorney May File Petition. – The district attorney of the prosecutorial district as defined in G.S. 7A-60 in which probation was imposed may file a petition to reduce, terminate, extend, modify, or revoke probation in the district court district as defined in G.S. 7A-133 or superior court district or set of districts as defined in G.S. 7A-41.1, as the case may be, where probation was imposed. Any petition filed by a district attorney pursuant to this subsection shall be served on the probationer by the supervising probation officer."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to petitions filed on or after that date.
